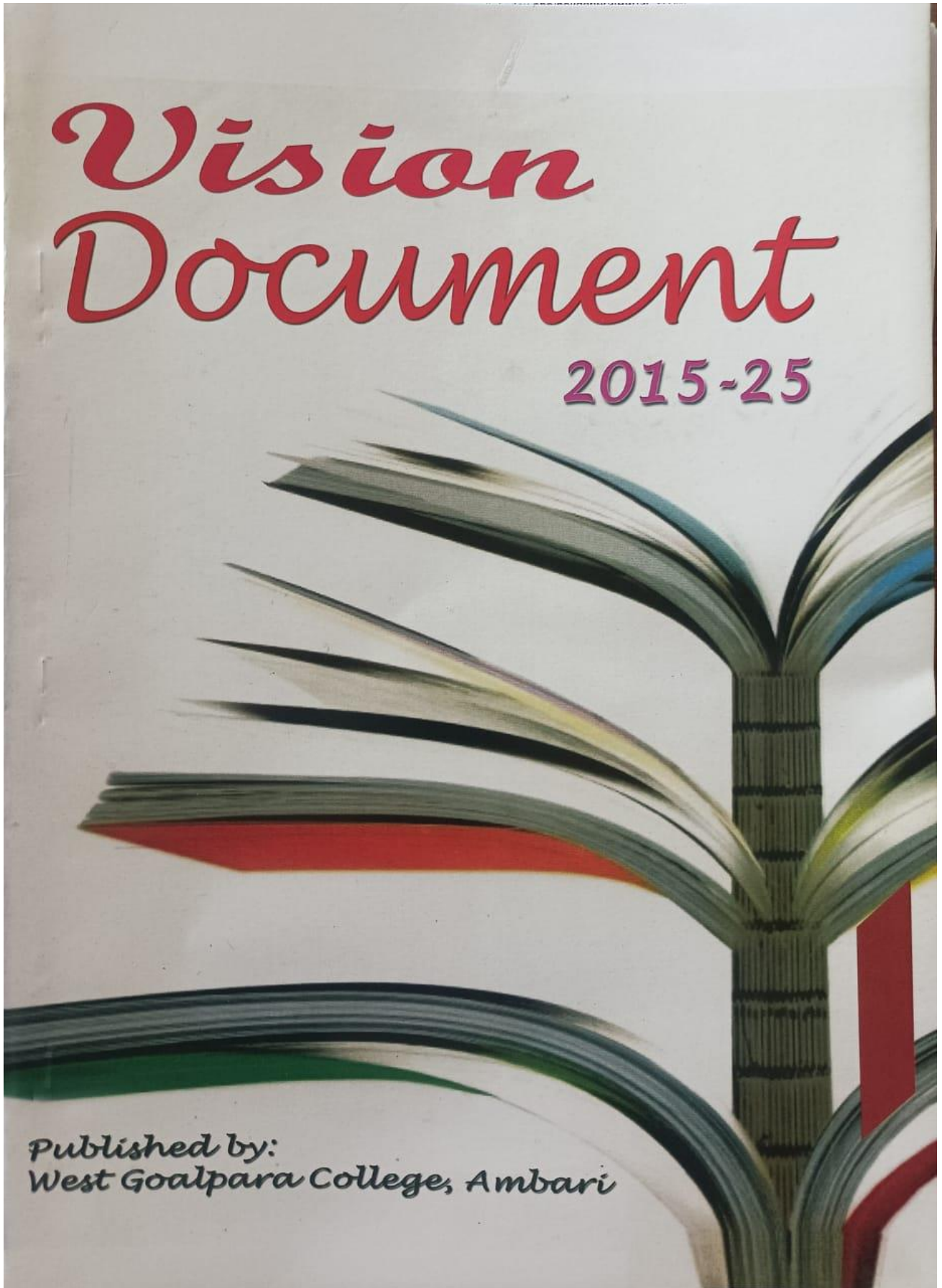

- (2) innovating ideas for the adventure in search of truth through way of reason.

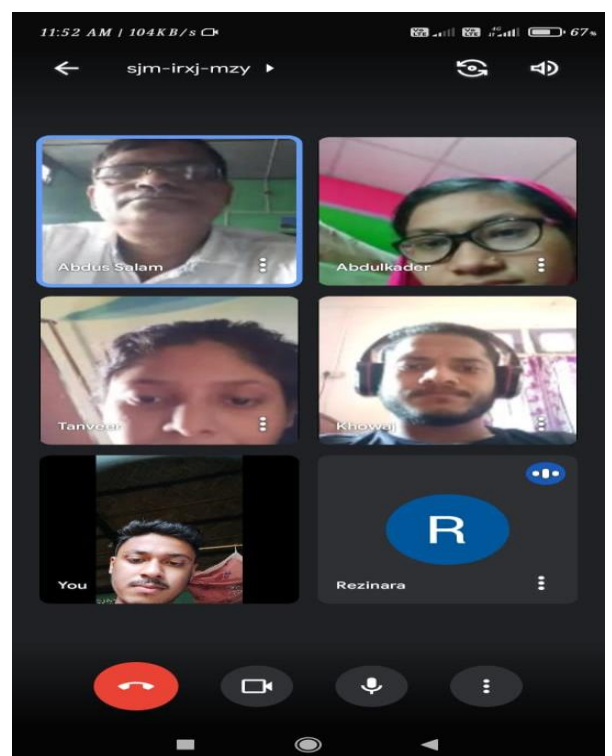
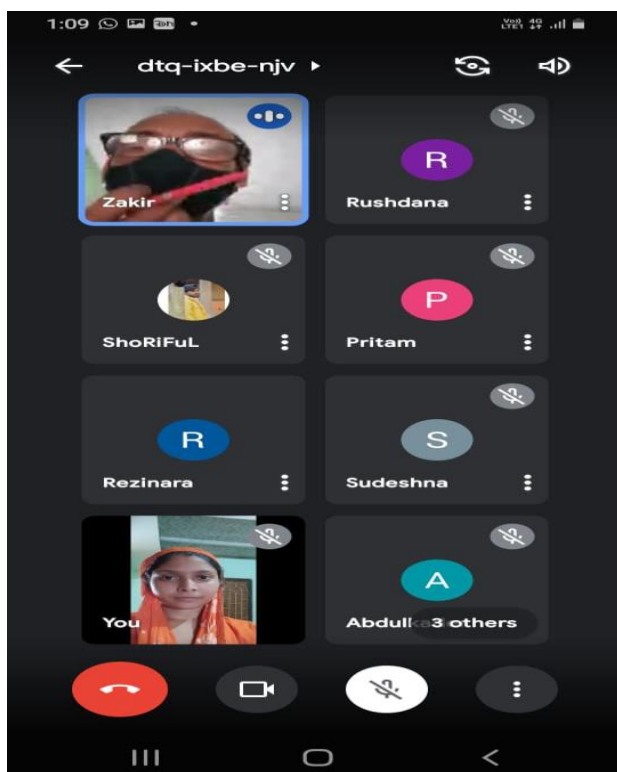
