1) **Title of the Practice:** Anti Ragging Campaign.

**Goal:** To create culture of ragging free environment, to create a friendly atmosphere and to grow good habits.

**Context:** Awareness programme against campus ragging is needed to aware the students. The ragging is disturbing reality in the higher education system of our country. Over the years ragging has claimed hundreds of innocent lives and has ruined the careers of bright students.

**The Practice:** To maintain a ragging free environment has formed an Anti-Ragging Cell which monitors

students' activities and ensures that the college enjoys and congenial educational environment. The entire college campus is under CCTV surveillance. **Title:** Tobacco – Drugs free programme.

**Goal:** to rescue/prevent our new generation from the trap of drugs-tobacco abuse.

**Context:** It is a disease that affects a person's brain and behaviour and leads to an inability to control the use of a legal or illegal drug or medicine. substances such as alcohol, nicotine are also considered drugs. the misuse and abuse of alcohol, tobacco, drugs affect the health and wellbeing of millions of people. under the "NDPS Act, it is illegal for a person to produce, manufacture, cultivate, sell, purchase, transport, store and consume any drugs. The narcotics control Bureau was set up with effect from March 1986.

**Practice:** Public meetings, demonstration, street drama, advertising campaigns and educational programmes are taken at our College. Our teachers and NSS wings meet public and arrange camps/lectures to encourage the people to stop smoking and taking drugs. We tried to explain the link between tobacco and heart and availability of solutions to reduce drugs related death.
